

1. Surah Al-Hujurat, verse 11 - 13.

Verse 11 :O you who believe! Let not a group mock another group; it may be that these are better than they; nor should women mock another women, it may be that these are better than they. Do not taunt one another nor call one another by nicknames. It is an evil thing [to be called a] bad name after faith. Those who do not repent are the unjust.

Verse 12 : O you who believe! Avoid much suspicion, for in some cases suspicion is a sin. Do not spy [on one another], nor backbite one another. Would any of you like to eat the flesh of his dead brother? Surely you would abhor it. Have fear of Allah. He is Relenting, Compassionate.

Verse 13 :O mankind! We have created you from a male and a female, and then rendered you nations and tribes so that you might know one another. The most honorable among you in the sight of Allah is he who is the most pious. Allah is indeed Knowing, Aware.

2. Surah Al-Qasas, verse 77.

Verse 77 : "But seek the abode of the Hereafter in that which Allah has given you, and forget not your portion of the world, and be kind even as Allah has been kind to you, and seek not corruption in the earth; for Allah loves not corrupters."

3. Surah Ar-Rum, verse 41.

Verse 41: Corruption has appeared on land and in the sea for what men's hands have earned, that He may make them taste a part of that which they have done, that they may return.

5. Surah An-Nisa', verse 163 - 166

Verse 163 : We reveal to you, as We revealed to Noah and the Prophets after him, and as We revealed to Abraham and Ishmael and Isaac and Jacob and the tribes, and Jesus and Job and Jonah and Aaron and Solomon, an as We gave David the Pslams.

Verse 164 : And Messengers We have mentioned to you before and Messengers We have not mentioned to you; and Allah spoke directly with Moses.

Verse 165 : Messengers of good news and of warning, in order that mankind might have no argument against Allah after the Messengers. And Allah was August, Wise.

Verse 166 : But Allah [Himself] bears witness concerning that which He has sent down to you; with His knowledge has He sent it down; and the angels also testify. And Allah is sufficient witness.

4. Surah Al'Araf, verse 56-58 & 85.

Verse 56 :Work not corruption in the earth after it has been set in order, and call on Him in fear and hope. Surely, the mercy of Allah is near to those who act with excellence.

Verse 57: And He it is who sends the winds as tidings heralding His mercy, till, when they bear a cloud heavy [with rain], We lead it to a dead land, and then cause water to descend and thereby bring forth fruits of every kind. Thus do We bring forth the dead.

Perhaps you will remember.

Verse 58 : And the good land brings forth its vegetation by permission of its Lord; while that which is bad, only evil comes forth [from it]. Thus do We explain the signs for people who gives thanks.

Verse 85 :And to Madyan [We sent as a Prophet] their brother, Shu'ayb. He said: "O my people! Worship Allah! You have no other god save Him. Indeed, a clear sign has come to you from your Lord; so give full measure and full weight, and wrong not mankind in their good, and work not corruption in the earth after it has been set in order. That will be the best for you, if you are believers.
